

Radio Drive Featuring Kevin Gullickson

"She Colors My World" is Kevin's 5th full CD recording as Radio Drive. Recording began in the fall of 2017 at his home studio with a release in April 2018. Kevin played all the parts on the songs and sang all vocals and harmonies. After mixing, Kevin worked with Robert L. Smith at Defy Recordings for the final mastering. Robert caught Kevin's interest, especially since he's worked with some of Kevin's biggest influences: **Paul McCartney, David Bowie** and **Aerosmith**, just to name a few.

For the first time Kevin recorded a cover song, **"Hey Bulldog"** by **The Beatles**. "I've always love that song", said Kevin. "It's always gone down so well when we perform that one live".

Even before it's release, three songs won awards from the **Akademia Music Awards**, an international indie music award. Three songs won in their own



category for March 2018: **"Sweet Thing"** won **Best Pop Rock Song**, **"A New Start"** won **Best Rock Song** and **"Hey Bulldog"** won **Best Cover Song**. Later in August, the Akademia awarded **"She Colors My World"** the Award of Excellence.

Radio Drive is an Alternative Pop Rock band featuring **Kevin Gullickson**. As the engine behind **Radio Drive**, Kevin has won international awards and nominations for his songs and music videos. The music of **Radio Drive** is being aired on radio around the world alongside major artists and is receiving rave reviews by music critics. He has been featured on web zines and radio shows in Europe, Canada and the USA.

Kevin's music has landed on charts on indie stations around the world, including Canada, Germany, the UK and the South Pacific. His music has been used on shows airing on **Animal Planet, National Geographic, Comedy Central, Fox Channels, History Channel, Spike TV** and **Discovery Channel** in the USA and TV programs in England, Mexico, New Zealand and Australia.
